The Modern Classic



- Berlin's oldest university
- Started in 1810 with 256 students and 52 professors
- 11 Faculties, offering all main disciplines of humanities, social and cultural sciences, human medicine, mathematics & natural sciences --"everything but engineering"
- Approx. 35.000 students
- 6.000 students from abroad
- 5.000 new students each year
- Over 400 tenured professors

Wilhelm von Humboldt A Modern Classic






- Philosopher & Politician
- Founded in 1810 by Wilhelm von Humboldt
- His idea: A new kind of university that guarantees
 - academic freedom / freedom of research
 - unity of the sciences in their disciplinary variety
 - reciprocal relationship of research and teaching
- The goal: to realise the university's societal responsibility.







- German naturalist and explorer
- Explorations in Latin America and Russia
- Inspired expansion / creation of Natural Sciences
- Public lectures "Cosmos"
- Pioneer of many subjects of the Natural Sciences



Important Tradition



- 29 Nobel Prize Winners
- Famous scholars: Einstein, Max Planck, Hegel
- Famous students: Bismarck, Karl Marx
- Jacob-and-Wilhelm-Grimm collection
- Winkelmann Institut




Humboldt International
