Assembly

You will need: Scissors, glue, ruler, a used ball-point pen

Assembly tip: Tracing along fold lines using a ruler and a dried-up pen will make folding easier, and result in sharper folds.

Notation Key: - - - - - Mountain fold - - - - - Valley fold ——— Cut line

● Glue tab

① Glue tabs with numbers
(Refer to the assembly instructions on the right.)

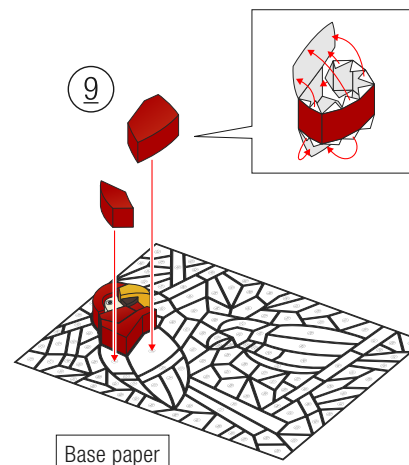


Warning: This craft requires the use of adhesives, scissors and other utensils which could be dangerous to small children. Please be sure to keep them away from children while you work.

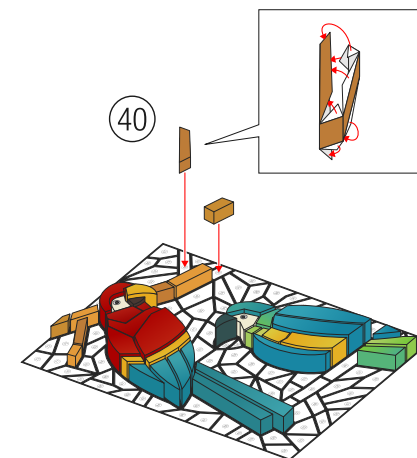

Assemble each part from ① to ③①, and glue them to the base paper in numerical order.



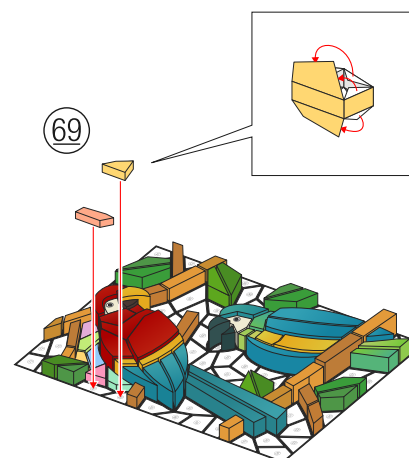

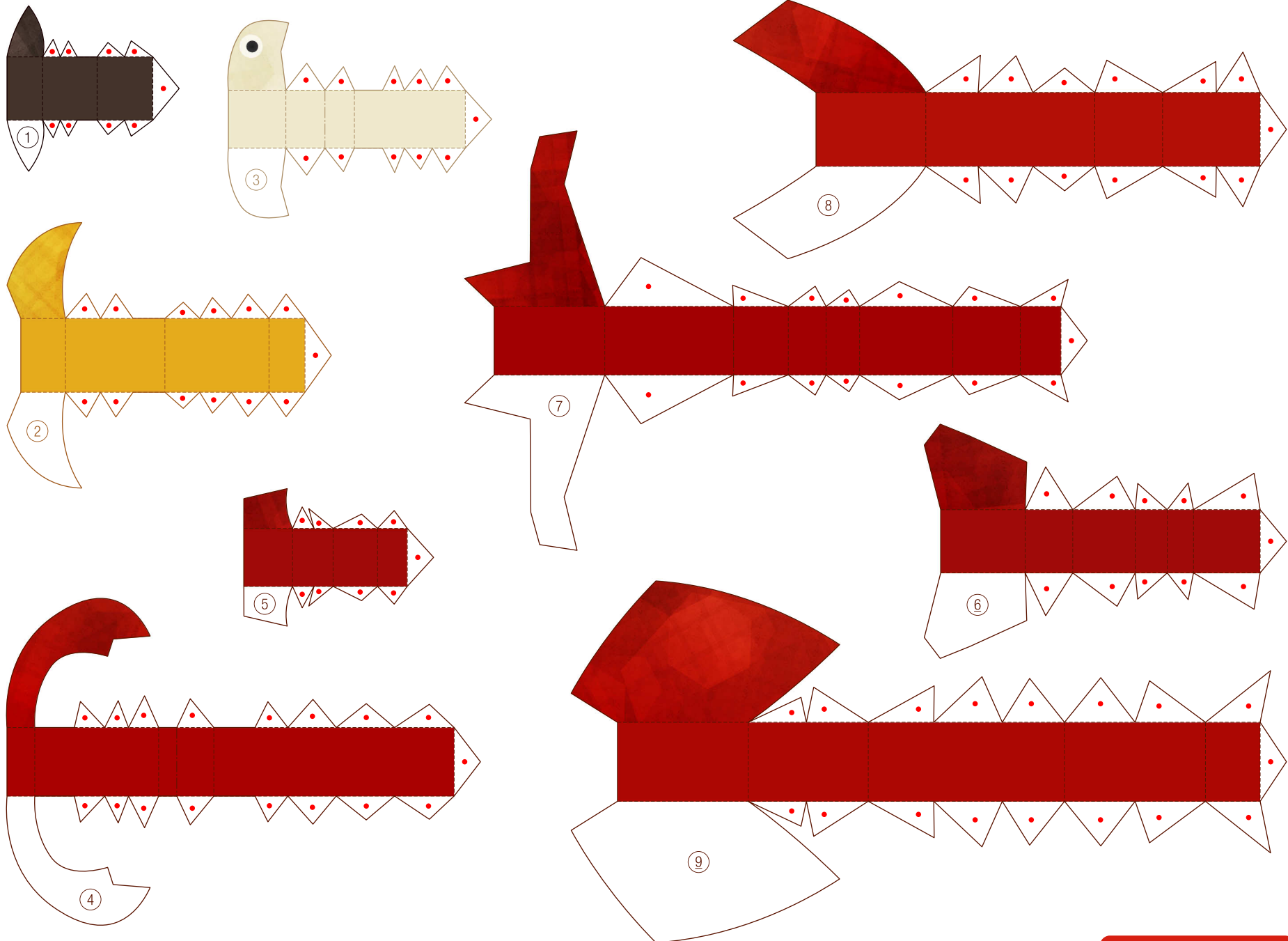
⑥② to ③③ are parts for the background (69 pieces).

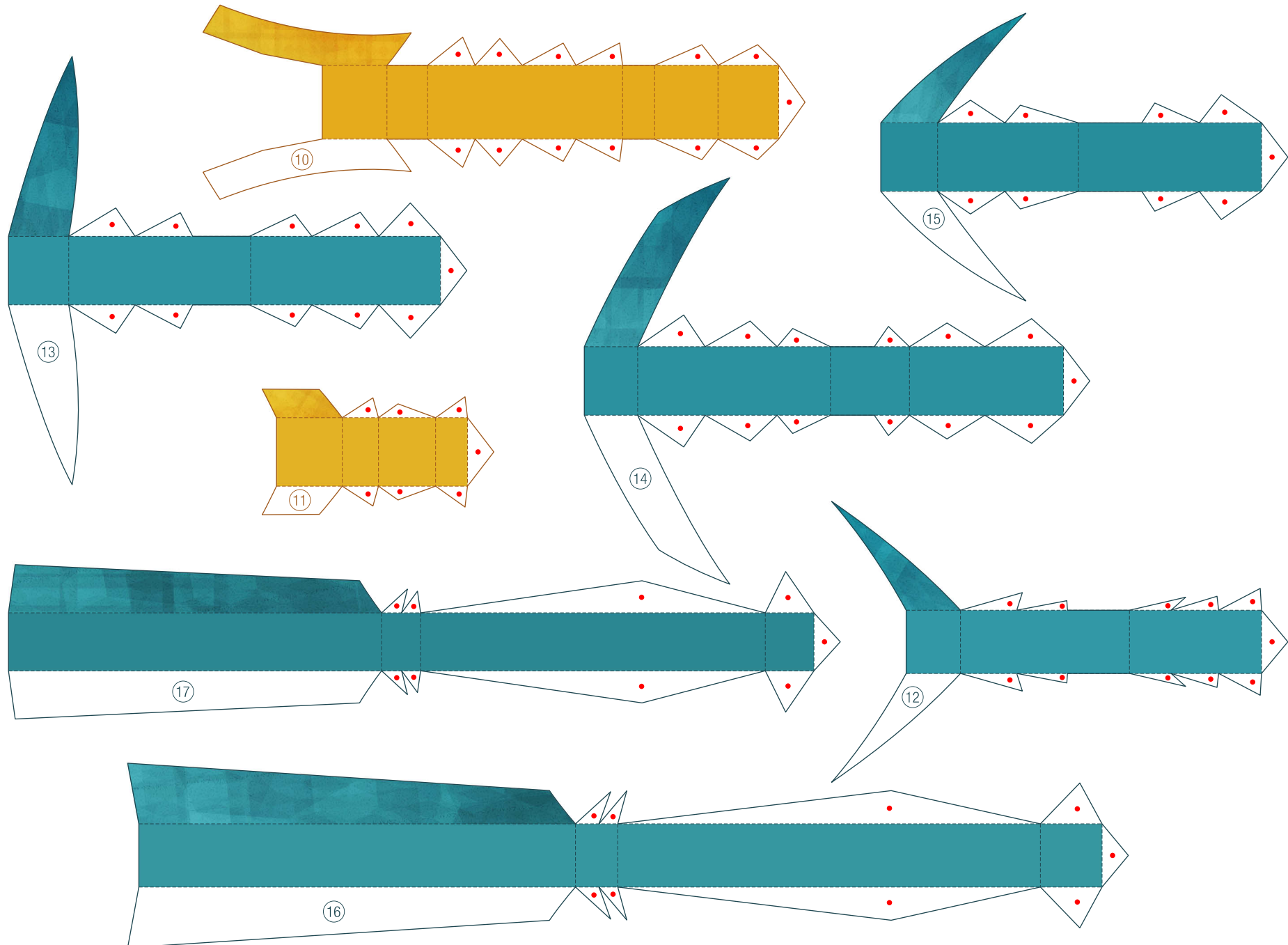


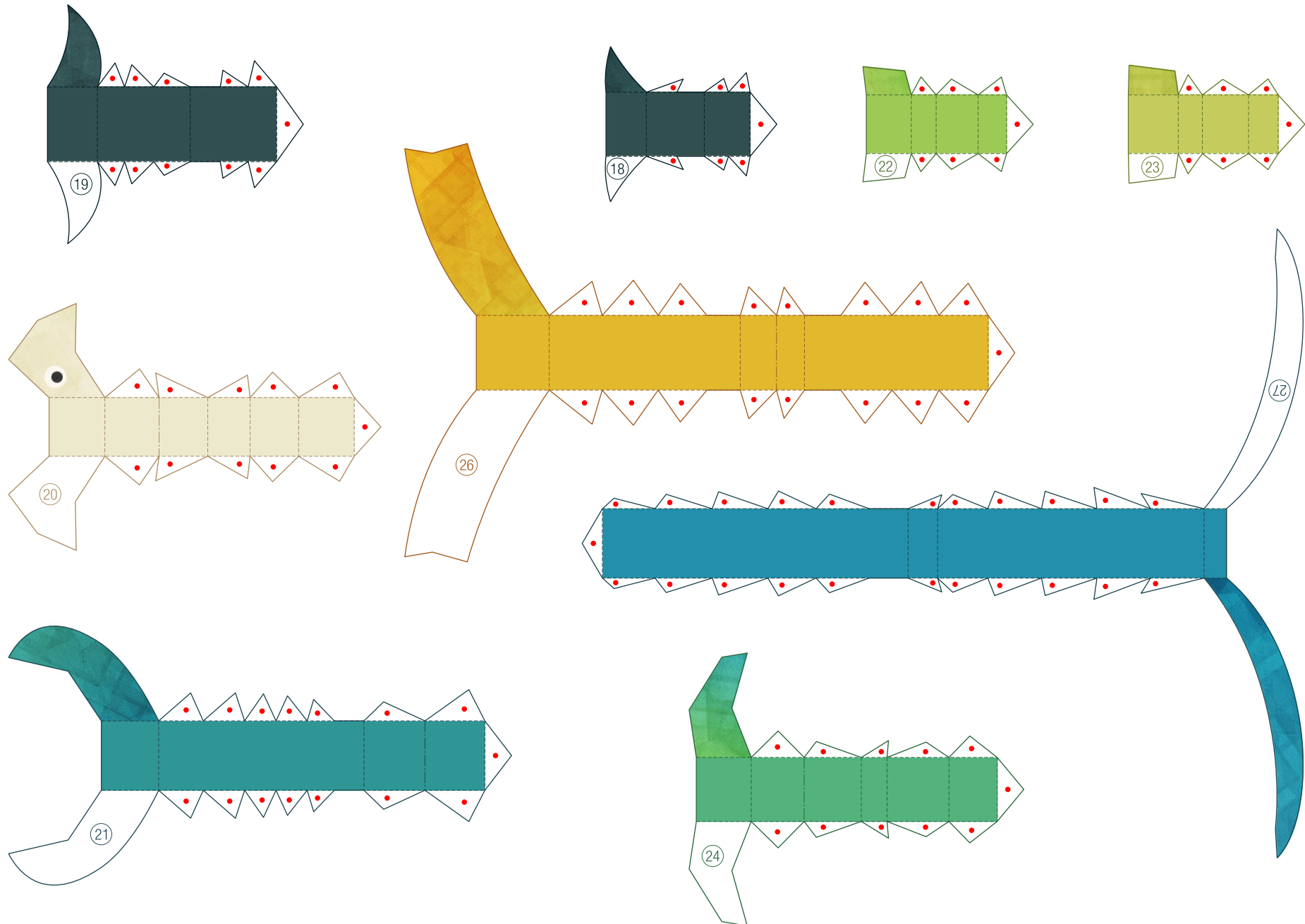

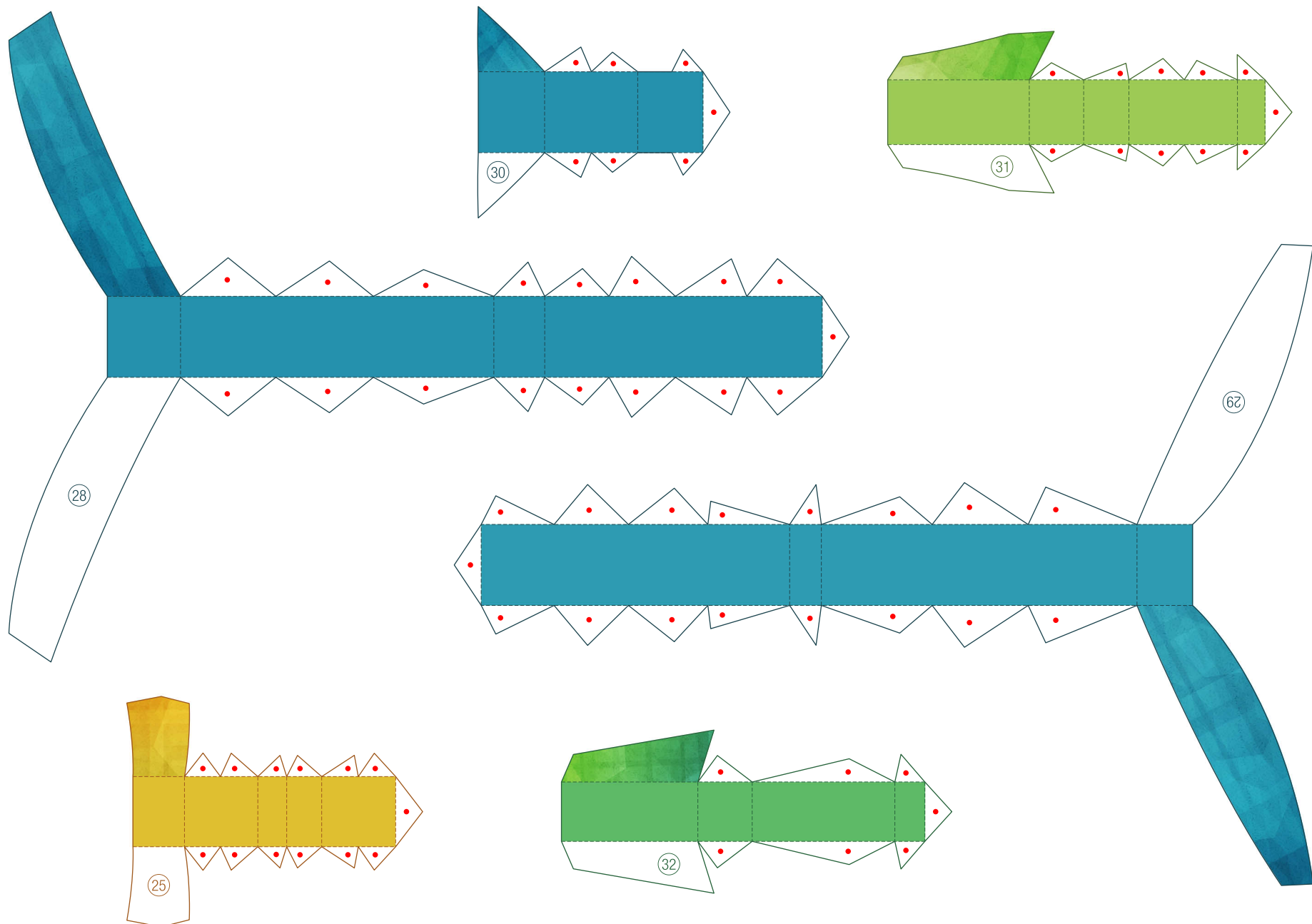
Glue all 130 parts, and you're done! Hang it up for display in a frame.

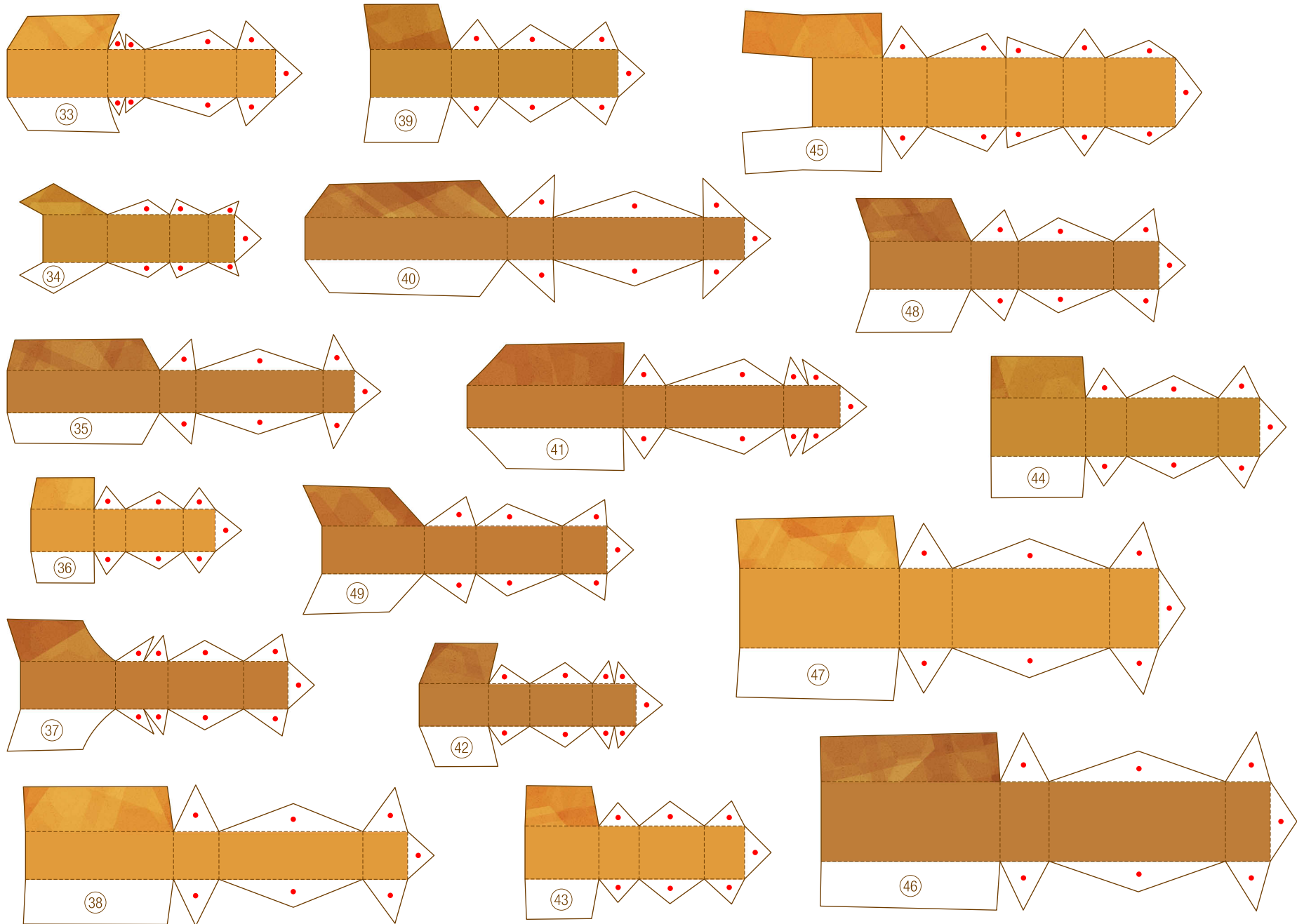


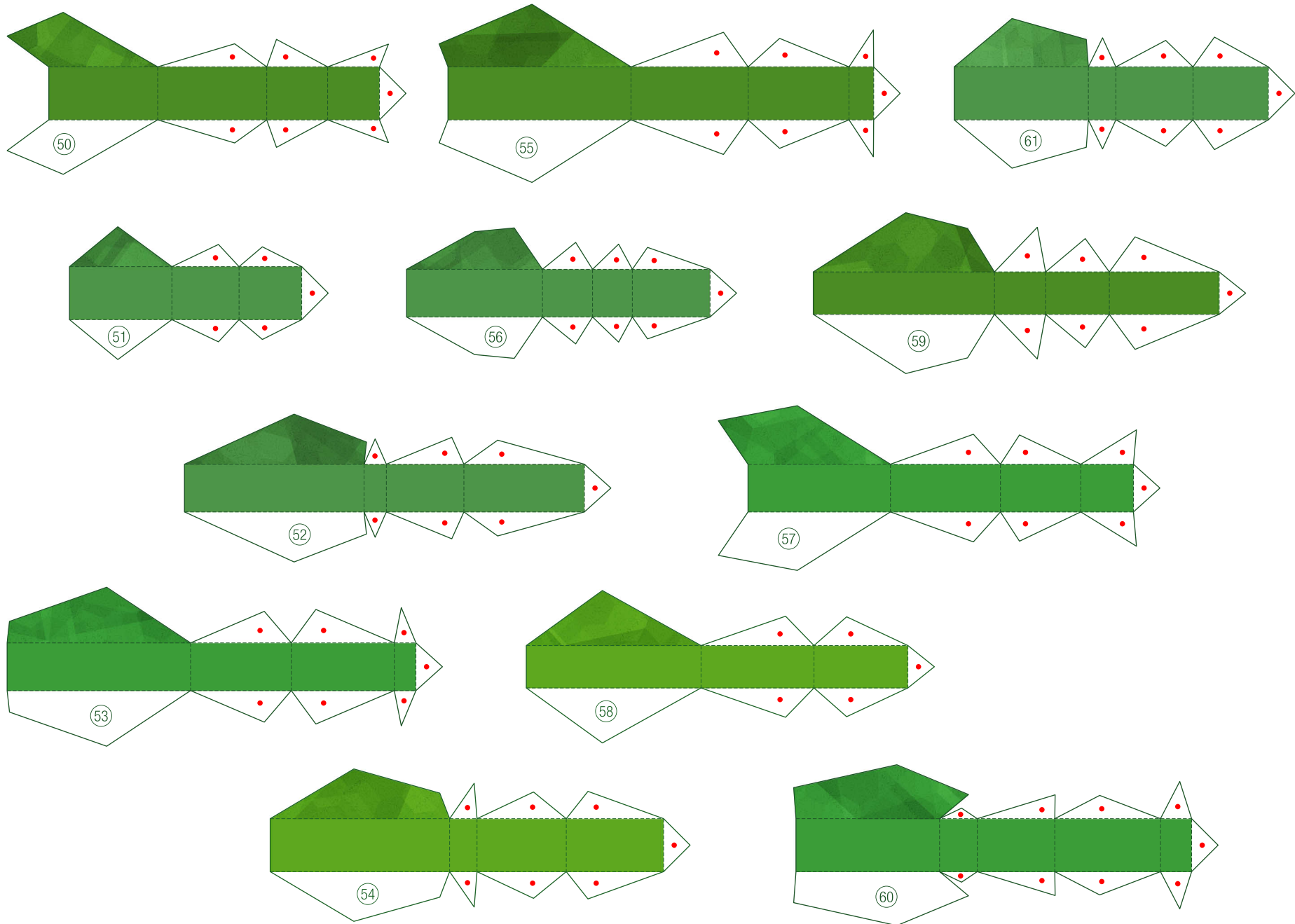


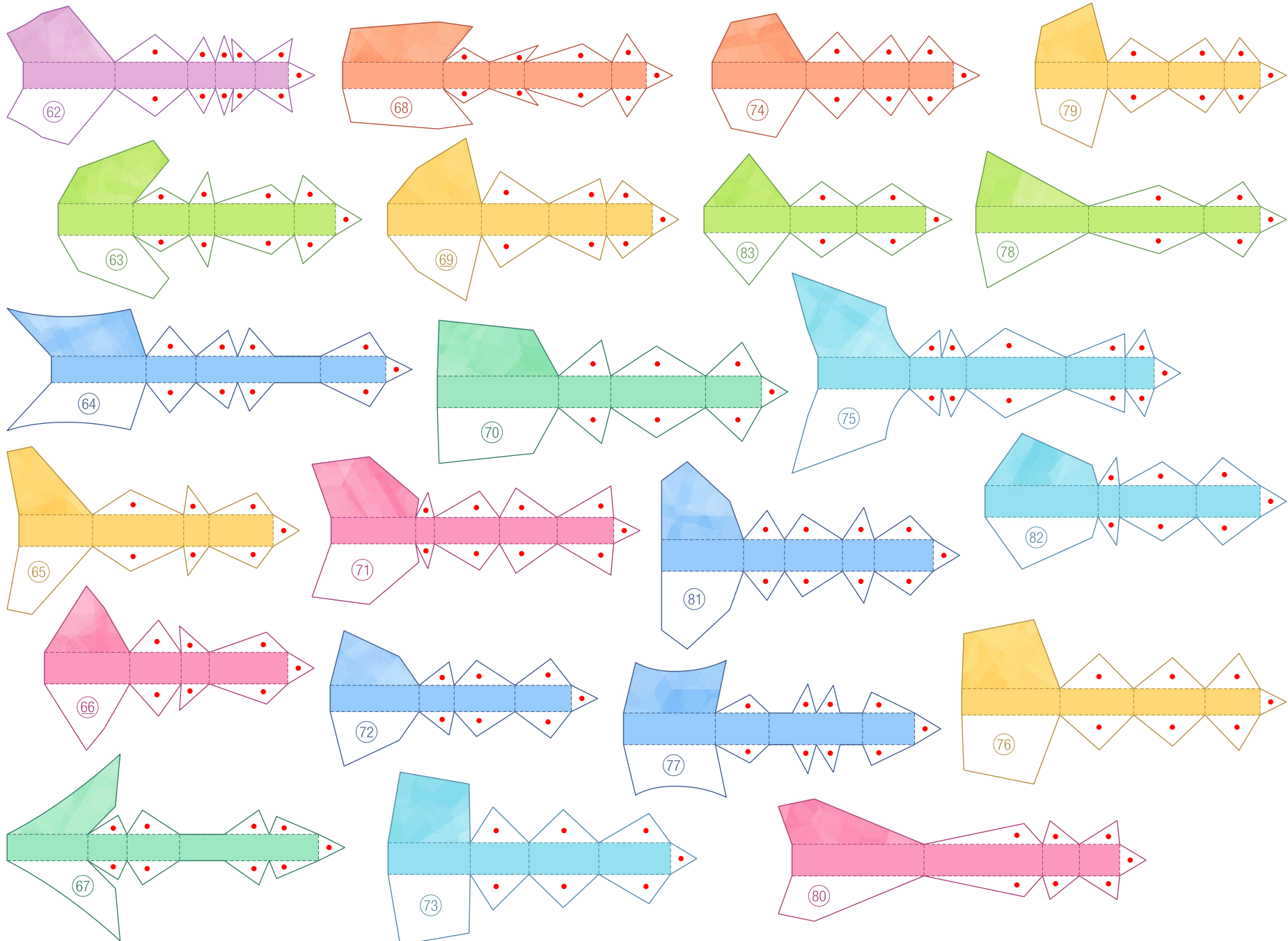


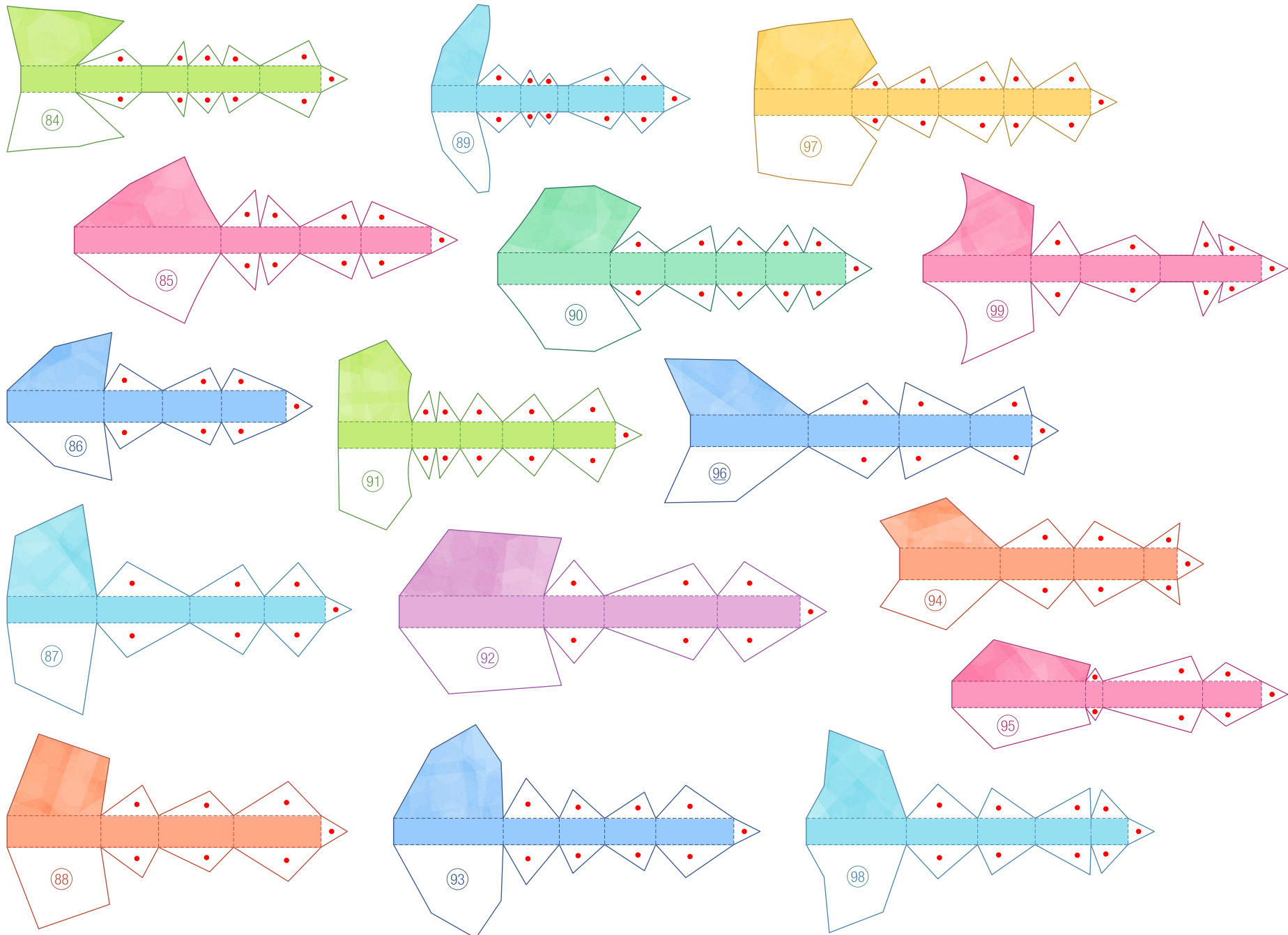


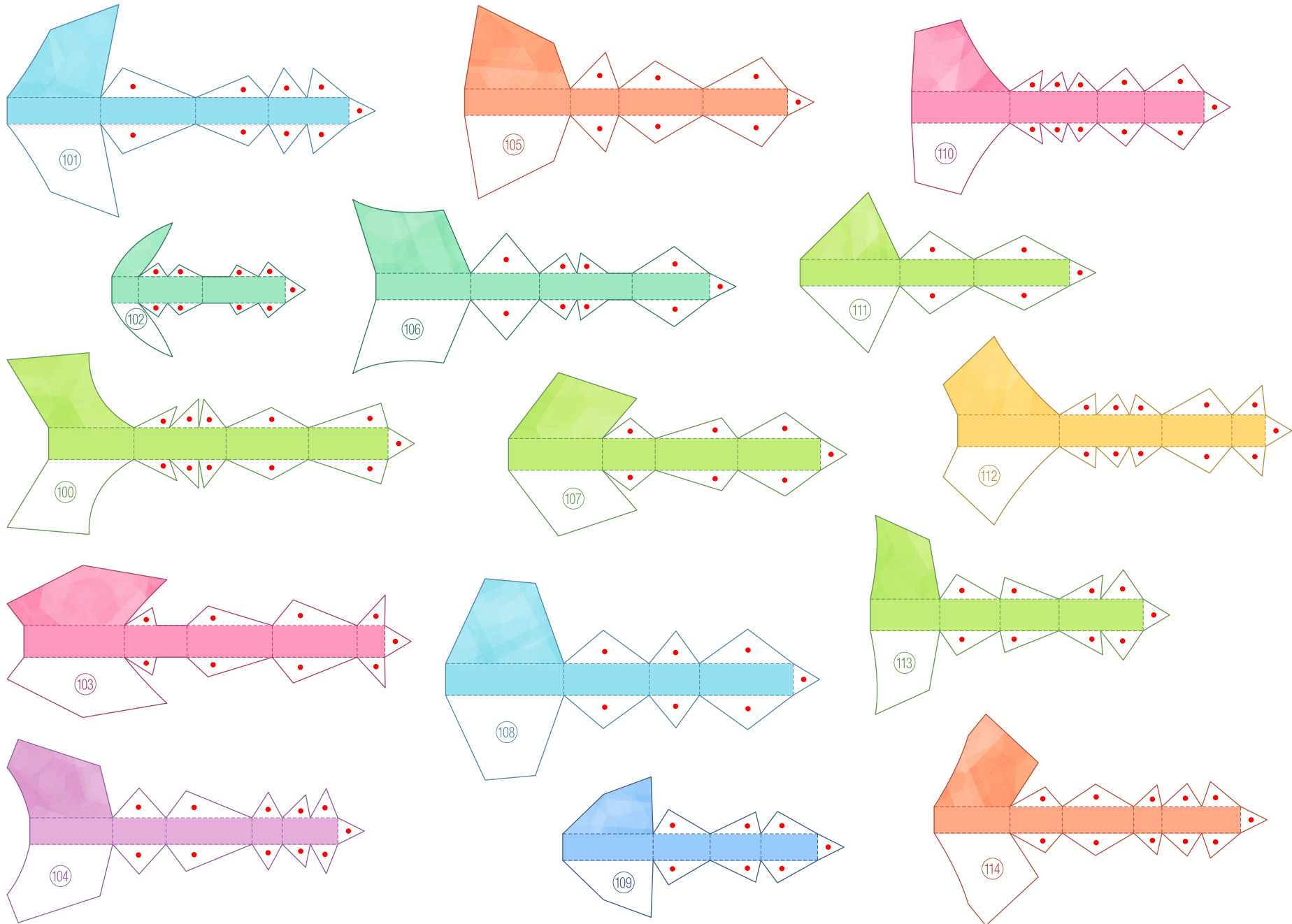


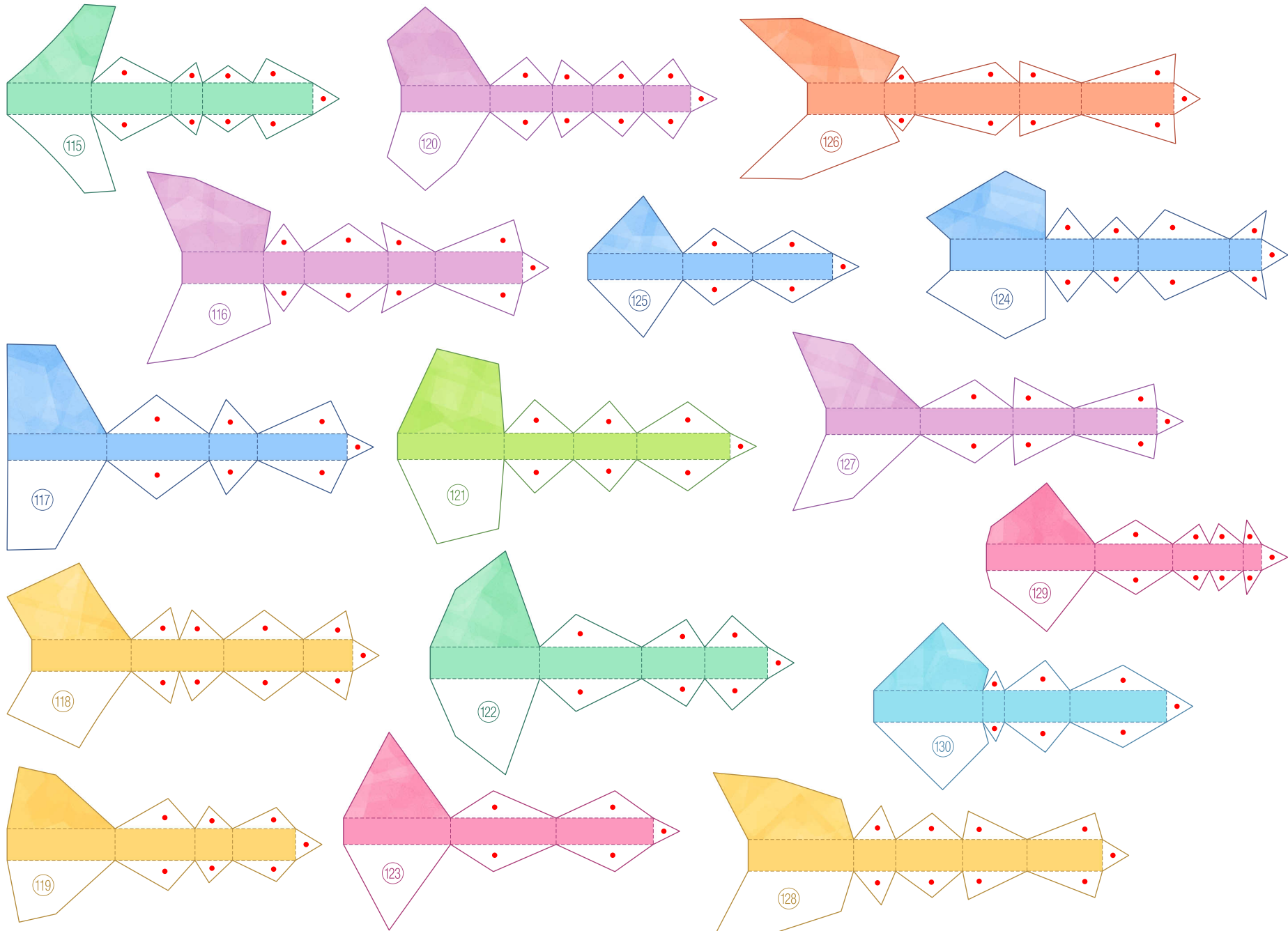
