

**This week, there is an important ceremony:  
the royal cremation ceremony  
so some groups of Thais people should behave properly.**

I would like to thank many readers for sharing.

The main points of my 3 articles are that I honored King Rama IX at a global level. I mention about this many times and used to interview Dr. Sumet Tantivejkul that His Majesty King Bhumibol Adulyadej best deserved for the Peace Nobel Prize.

To win the Nobel Prize needs a long-time planning and his works must be globally publicized.

It is regretful that the past governments did not work hard on this.

If they do their best on this during his lifetime, he might have been awarded this Nobel Prize.

Nobel Prize process requires nomination. We must synergize to explain to the Nobel Prize Committee to understand his works on many projects.

At least 2 major works are enough.

(1) On October 14, 1973 event, he played his role to resolve domestic conflict with non-violent approach to achieve peace and sustainability. He royally approved Prof. Sanya Dharmasakti to be the Prime Minister.

(2) On Black May, he was the mediator between Gen. Suchinda Kraprayoon and Maj. Gen. Chamlong Srimuang.

Moreover, he developed Thailand to support Thais' living with balance and sufficiency led to Sufficiency Economy.

In this article, I would like to cite my 3 works applying the King's Philosophy as follows.

(1) As a former President of Debsirin School Alumni Association under the Royal Patronage, I had an opportunity to work with HSH Prince Bhisadej Rajani in establishing Ban Khum School at Doi Angkhang to be Debsirin 9 School Royal Project under Royal Patronage. It was my and Debsirin school members' pride in serving King Rama IX's educational works. Nowadays, Debsirin 9 School Royal Project under Royal Patronage has more than 300 hill-tribe students on Doi Angkhang. The students are of high quality. They greatly appreciate and honor King Rama IX's kindness.

(2) I invited Prof. Kasem Wattanachai, MD, Privy Councilor to deliver the keynote speech on Sufficiency Economy on October 28-29, 2002. Later, I invited Dr. Sumet Tantivejkul, Secretary-General, Chaipattana Foundation to deliver the keynote speech on the same topic on March 14-15, 2006 in Yunnan Province, China. It was international relation promotion by Foundation for International Human Resource Development (FIHRD). This was the origin of People-to-People Diplomacy (PPD). Many organizations pursue international relation promotion policy after me. We internationally publicize King Rama IX's works to promote good international relation with foreign countries.

(3) During the past 2-3 years, I took my students from EGAT and PSU to study visit and listen to the presentation on Chaipattana Foundation. Dr. Sumet Tantivejkul, Secretary-General, and ML Jirapan Taweewong, Deputy Secretary-General, warmly welcomed them.

King Rama IX initiated many projects under Chaipattana Foundation. They link with Office of the Royal Development Projects Board (ORDPB) taking care of more than 4,000 projects.

I think that there should be cooperation between PSU and EGAT to successfully apply to expand activities and do it with continuity. Then, the grass-root Thais can survive from the poverty.

If Ministry of Agriculture and Cooperatives of Thailand cooperates with Chaipattana Foundation and more than 4,000 Royal Projects to apply the King's Philosophy as practical roadmap, Thai agriculture and farmers will greatly prosper.
